



CE Marking of Gas Appliances Regulation (EU) 2016/426

What is CE marking ?

CE marking is the proof of conformity to requirements of European directives/regulations which apply to the product.

Gas appliances are mainly regulated by Regulation (EU) 2016/426. Boiler Efficiency is regulated by 92/42/EEC directive.

Which Gas Appliances are in the scope ?

Regulation (EU) 2016/426 applies to gas appliances and fittings hereunder listed :

- Cooking appliances (household or professional),
- Heating appliances (boilers, burners, space heaters, air heaters, ...),
- Hot water producers (storage or instantaneous),
- Refrigeration appliances,
- Lighting appliances,
- Washing appliances (clothes washers and dryers, dish washers, laundry appliances),
- Fittings (safety devices, controlling devices or regulating devices and sub-assemblies thereof, designed to be incorporated into an appliance or to be assembled to constitute an appliance).

Everything is under control

Gas appliances are tested in laboratories recognized by CERTIGAZ and manufacturing premises are under surveillance according to applicable standards and provisions of the Regulation (EU) 2016/426.

Beyond standards

Gas Certification Rules for CE marking are drafted with the participation of all interested parties: manufacturers, trade unions, gas utilities, consumers, authorities, technical centres ...

Those CE Rules include :

- Applicable standards,
- Additional specification related to products and quality systems of manufacturers,
- Practical route for evaluation and surveillance of products and manufacturing premises.

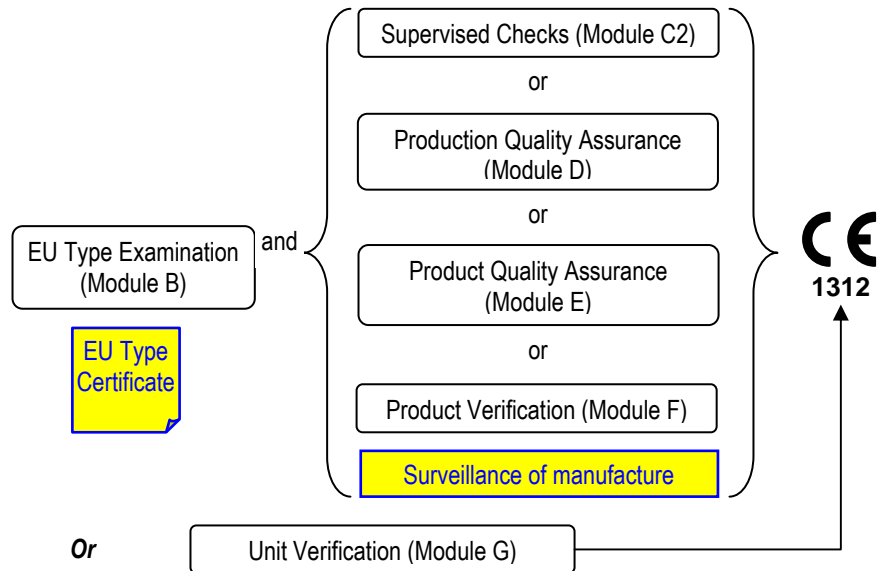

Safety and free movement

CE Marking according to Regulation (EU) 2016/426 guarantees **safety** and **rational use of energy** for gas appliances. As a passport for Europe, CE Marking ensures free movement of products in the different countries of European Union.

Conformity assessment procedures

CE marking can be affixed on gas appliances which conform to an EU type examination certificate and are manufactured under an appropriate EC surveillance, or when they have been delivered a certificate of unit verification.



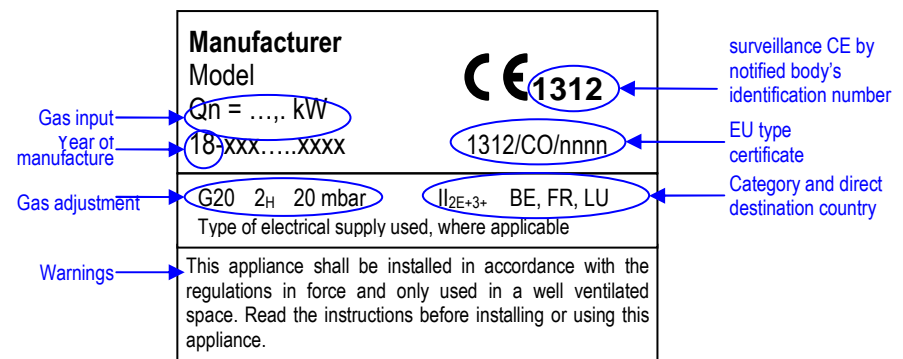
CE 1312 : Sign of confidence

Procedures for EU type examination and CE surveillance are conducted by a Notified Body appointed by every member state and notified to EC Commission. In France, ministry in charge of Gas Security has appointed CERTIGAZ as Notified Body for Regulation (EU) 2016/426 « Gas Appliances ». Identification number of CERTIGAZ is 1312.
